

Call for Entries Architecture in Wales

Carmarthenshire National Eisteddfod

1-9 August 2014

An exhibition of recent architecture is to be held at **the National Eisteddfod of Wales, Carmarthenshire 2014**, supported by the **Design Commission for Wales**.

Exhibition entries are invited from architects, or group of architects, for buildings whose practical date of completion was between 1 January 2011 and 14 March 2014.

Successful entries for inclusion in the exhibition will also be considered for the two following prestigious awards:

The Gold Medal for Architecture

(Alwyn Lloyd Memorial Medal)

Supported by the Design Commission for Wales

A silver-gilt replica of the original gold medal will be awarded to the architect or architects responsible for a building, or group of buildings, completed between 1 January 2011 and 14 March 2014 and recommended to the Eisteddfod as being of greatest merit.

Plaque of Merit

To honour smaller projects of a high standard of design.

Architects are invited to submit either newly built or refurbished projects that satisfy the following criteria:

- constructed in Wales
- final account of up to £750,000
- completed between 1 January 2011 and 14 March 2014
- enhances the environment

Entries for 2014 will be selected by Elfed Roberts (Grŵp Gwalia, Swansea) and Ann-Marie Smale (Powell Dobson, Cardiff).

The exhibition aims to enhance the profile of architecture in Wales through the presentation of drawings and models, selected for their quality and their ability to convey the richness of architecture and its value in the culture of Wales. Elements of the exhibition will also be displayed by means of digital projection.
